HOW WILL YOU BENEFIT?

The unique approach is to understand molding from the plastic's point of view while it is heated, made to flow, pressurized and cooled. This will be related to part design, mold design and build, and how to challenge the mold during a tryout so it is ready to run with the best in production.

The courses teach why things happen as opposed to simply providing recipes of how to.

The cornerstone of this training is the use of data from within the mold so actual in-mold data of pressures, flow rates, temperatures, mold deflections, cavity balance and cooling rates can be observed to allow analytical problem solving instead of trial and error. All of this is done in real time.

- An RJG training series must be completed as in-plant training only.

- Must have at least 3 people remain on staff who have attended the Systematic Molding for Mold Builders & Tooling Engineers and Sensor Installation and Troubleshooting training in order to maintain mold building facility certification.
